



THE ^{God}_{Gravity} FACTOR : SOURCE OF ALL ENERGY

PERPETUAL ETERNAL MOTION AND ENERGY GENERATION



'With God all things are possible.'

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Scientific knowledge and laws have to be based on **observable, repeatable and predictable facts**. But the Law of Thermodynamics, *'energy cannot be created or destroyed,'* does not meet this criteria; it is just plain bigotry. Just because nobody knows how God exists and how energy is created does not prove that energy cannot be created, much less that there is no God.

Since existence of God is beyond the physical realm, science often comes across as outright atheism. Yet, both, energy and the Biblical Eternal God, have great similarities. God certainly cannot be created nor destroyed. Yet the eternally enigmatic God keeps on popping up as the Prime Mover in our mind and in secular philosophy. God energetically moves things. He makes things happen ex nihilo – from what appears to be nothing. He made man, a living soul with life, breath and a complex computer-like mind.

Regrettably, believers in the Law of Thermodynamics are greatly handicapped. For the last 200 years the so-called *'Law of thermodynamics'* crippled scientists, who have been brainwashed into believing: *'Energy cannot be created.'* *'Perpetual motion is impossible.'* *'It can't be done, because nobody ever did it before.'*

The Law of Thermodynamics is fake. Not only is it scientifically unproven; it satanically opposes the very essence of God, the fundamental concept, which recognizes the Eternal God as God, with whom **'NOTHING IS IMPOSSIBLE.'** (Luke 1: 37; Matthew 19: 26) The Law of Thermodynamics is the manifesto of 19th Century atheism. It is proven wrong: Perpetual eternal motion exists. Energy can be multiplied.

Perpetual eternal motion can be (1) theoretically illustrated and (2) can be observed in reality:

(1) If a hypothetical vacuum tube were to exist from North Pole to South Pole of Earth, and if a golf ball were dropped into said tube at the North Pole, gravity would pull the ball to Earth's center, and momentum would propel the ball to the South Pole, only to repeat the cycle eternally. This hypothetical illustration is manifested as reality a billion times in the universe.

(2) Gravity pulls the Moon toward the center of Earth, but since the Earth rotates around the Sun, at a speed of 30 km/second, the Moon never catches up with Earth. Like a corkscrew Yoyo, the Moon is eternally spiraling around Earth on its journey around the Sun.

Acknowledging this changes false fake concepts about the universe (NB: Energy is $E = mv$, NOT $E \neq mc^2$)

(1) The constant gravitational force and energy that pulls the Moon toward Earth introduces the concept of eternity: In each revolution, $E = mv$ of the Moon is eternally matched and duplicated by $G = m_1m_2/d^2$ of Earth and Moon. (2) All gravitational forces have yet a greater impact, which requires the use of a term that defines the unique essence of yet another term, the Biblical Eternal God: OMNIPRESENT. If forces of gravity were not, an ever-present omnipresent reality, but traveled at the speed of light, as Einstein mused, the universe, as we know could not exist, for If Einstein were right, the force of gravity would be delayed by two seconds, between Moon and earth, and the Moon would progressively lag behind and drift out of earth's orbit.

Ex nihilo creation of new energy escaped atheistic deniers of creation, because of their insistence on the First Law of Thermodynamics. Their unbelief in the Eternal God worked against them, for they do not believe that *'with God all things are possible.'*

Granted, nobody understands or can define gravity, energy, or God. However, they are realities that make the heretofore impossible possible, which is, at least in part, a matter of faith. But as a speedometer cannot measure temperature, and as a thermometer cannot measure speed, so no physical experimentation or evidence can prove to an atheist that God exists, unless a new mindset sets in: *'To approach God presupposes believing that He exists, and that He responds to them, who diligently seek Him.'* (Hebrews 11: 6) So in the end, though natural revelation reveals God to apprehend Him presupposes faith in His Word.
